



**A Comparative Study of Personality Traits of Inter Collegiate Judo and Wrestling Male
Players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University**

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Abstract

The motivation behind the present examination was to look at the second request personality traits of Inter-university Judo and Wrestling players of Dr. Babaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. The examination led on 50 examples, comprising of 25 Judo and 25 Wrestling Inter university male players of Dr. Babaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. Second request personality traits were gotten by administrating R. B. Cattell's Sixteen Personality Factor poll. The information gathered through this test were investigated regarding eight second request personality traits for example extraversion, uneasiness, extreme balance, reliance, control, change, authority and innovativeness. T test was applied to register the importance of contrasts among two gatherings. The hugeness of information was made a decision at 05 level. The consequence of the investigation shows that personality traits of Judo and Wrestling Inter university male players of Dr. Babaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University were unique.

Introduction :

Sports Personality of an individual has certain qualities which he imparts to other people and simultaneously certain different attributes which are special to him.

Sports Personality is a result of organic and social legacy. Sports Personality traits might be characterized as, "A traits is a suffering attribute of an individual that can be seen in a

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wide assortment of circumstances and can be utilized to portray the conduct of most people."

The motivation behind this investigation was to look at the personality traits of Inter-university Judo and Wrestling male players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University

Methodology :

Objectives:

- 1 To measure second order personality traits of inter collegiate male Judo players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada.
- 2 To measure second order personality traits of inter collegiate male Wrestling players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada.
- 3 To compare mean score of second order personality traits of inter collegiate Judo and Wrestling male players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada.

Hypothesis :

- 1 There would be significance difference on extraversion personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.
- 2 There would be significance difference on anxiety personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.
- 3 There would be significance difference on tough poise personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.
- 4 There would be significance difference on dependence personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.
- 5 There would be significance difference on control personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

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6 There would be significance difference on adjustment personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

7 There would be significance difference on leadership personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

8 There would be significance difference on creativity personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

Selection of Sample:

The sample consists of fifty players of Judo and Wrestling who participated at intercollegiate level were selected as subject of the study. In which twenty five players of Judo and twenty five players of Wrestling were taken. A purposive sampling method was adopted to collect the required data of Judo and Wrestling male intercollegiate male players.

Tools Used :

R. B. Cattell's Sixteen personality factors test was used for data collection. This test consists of 187 questions. Forty five to sixty minutes is required for administration of this test

Statistics Used :

T test has been applied to find out the significant differences among two groups at .05 levels of significance.

Results And Discussions :

The comparative statistical measures of extraversion, anxiety, tough poise, dependence, control adjustment, leadership and creativity of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Inter collegiate Judo and Wrestling male players were calculated and presented in Tables 1.

T-ratio regarding the level of significance were calculated at .05 level of significance for all eight second order personality traits. It was inferred that the differences of means of individual games male players were significant for extraversion, anxiety, tough poise, dependence, control, adjustment and leadership except creativity which was insignificant at .05 level of significance.

Hence the two groups of players of individual game male players differ in all above second order personality trait factors except creativity at .05 level. So the first to seventh hypotheses were accepted and eighth hypotheses was rejected.

CONCLUSIONS:

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1 There is significance difference on extraversion personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

2 There is significance difference on anxiety personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

3 There is significance difference on tough poise personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

4 There is significance difference on dependence personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

5 There is significance difference on control personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

6 There is significance difference on adjustment personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

7 There is significance difference on leadership personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

8 There is insignificance difference on creativity personality trait factor between Judo and Wrestling intercollegiate male Players.

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
