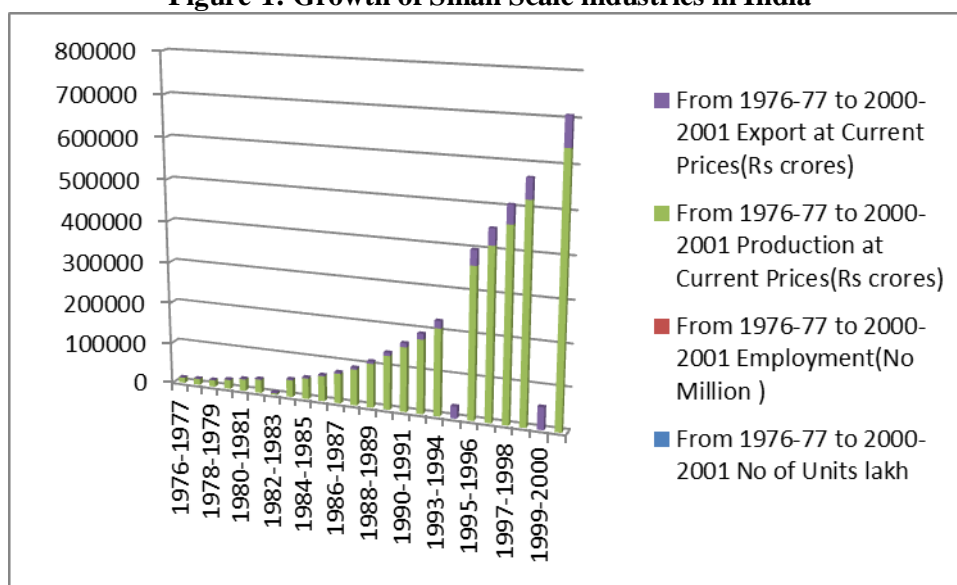
GROWTH OF SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES IN INDIA:
